

Short Drive 3

Goulburn to Crookwell via Taralga, Laggan, Pejar Dam & Kingsdale Driving Time: 1hr 37mins - Distance: 126km

Depart Goulburn, heading north along Taralga Road you will take in the rolling hills and astonishing wind turbines as you drive through the countryside to Taralga. Once there you will find some fantastic historical buildings dating back to the 1860s. Leaving Taralga along the Laggan-Taralga Road, you will pass through Laggan before arriving in Crookwell. On the scenic tour south back to Goulburn along Crookwell Road, you will find Pejar Dam. Pejar Dam is a popular spot for trout anglers, stocked with rainbow and brown trout. Electric powered and unpowered boats as well as kayaks/canoes are all permitted with barbeques, picnic shelters, untreated water and rubbish bins all provided. As you continue down Crookwell Road you'll pass the beautiful & picturesque locality of Kingsdale, overlooking Lake Sooley before arriving back in Goulburn.



Short Drive 4

Goulburn to Tarago via Lake Bathurst, Windellama & Quialigo Driving Time: 1hr 17mins - Distance: 103.3km

Depart Goulburn, heading south along Braidwood Road, passing through Lake Bathurst to Tarago. Lake Bathurst is not accessible to the public and is not a typical "lake" as it is empty most months of the year but, in season is actually a wetland haven for wading birds. You will also find some astounding WWII fuel tanks hidden away in hills around Lake Bathurst. Once in Tarago you will find some stunning historic buildings dating back to the 1840s. As you depart Tarago, heading east along Lumley Road, you will turn right onto Cullulla Road and left onto Oallen Ford Road before arriving in the picturesque locality of Windellama. The trip north-west along Windellama Road takes you past Quialigo and the Goulburn Airport before arriving back in Goulburn.



A Guide to Short Drives

Short Drive 1

Goulburn to Breadalbane via Parkesbourne

Driving Time: 50mins - Distance: 56.2km

Depart Goulburn, heading west along Addison Street/Gurrundah Road and turn left onto Merilla Lane to see a picture perfect piece of countryside in Parkesbourne. From here travel along Breadalbane Road onto Breadalbane, made famous by the notorious Ben Hall and his gang in the 1860s with plenty of beautiful period buildings to see. Depart Breadalbane on Cullerin Road, turning onto the Hume Highway and passing Yarra at the intersection of the Federal and Hume Highways before coming back into Goulburn along Hume Street.

Short Drive 2

Goulburn to Tallong via Bungonia, Marulan, Wingello & Towrang

Driving Time: 2hr 1min - Distance: 127.3km incl. unsealed roads

Depart Goulburn, heading southeast on Mountain Ash Road to Bungonia. A short drive from Bungonia, along Lookdown Road is Bungonia National Park and its scenic lookouts. Depart Bungonia via Jerrara Road, turn right onto the Hume Highway briefly before turning left onto George Street to Marulan, the only town on the 150th Meridian. Continue along George Street and rejoin the Hume Highway. After a short distance, turn right onto Highland Way and follow it through Tallong to Wingello. Detours from Tallong lead to Long Point and Badgerys Lookouts with views over Morton National Park and the Shoalhaven Gorge. Wingello delights with aromas from pine and eucalypt trees. From Wingello, take Murrimba Road to the Hume Highway, turn left before a quick right-hand turn onto Inverary Road. Follow Inverary Road to the end and turn left onto Canyonleigh Road. Follow to the end before turning right onto Brayton Road and immediately left onto Bulls Pit Road. Turn left onto Towrang Road to reach the historic Towrang Stockade and convict-built bridge. Rejoin the Hume Highway for the return drive to Goulburn.
